

Please begin the process of securing your travel visas for entry into the United States by applying online at <http://www.travel.state.gov>.



## Important Information and Deadlines

Please be aware that securing visas for this competition needs to be prioritized. USAW and the United States State Department urges all delegations to begin the application process immediately.

- *Take note that recently a global visa database issue has shut down and back logged all foreign visa applications. Therefore it is important to realize that technology can delay the visa process. Please plan accordingly.*
- *For Some countries visa applications may take up to 90 to 120 days. Please communicate with local US Embassy for details.*

- File individual DS-160 applications for each delegate and pay all visa fees
- Schedule an appointment for each individual
- Passports expiration date needs to exceed 6 months past Competition date
- On day of interview
  - Each individual should take copy of invitation letter
  - Take UWW license book which proves delegate is an athlete
  - Any additional diplomas or documents which allude to individual success

The following regulations will be strictly followed. Variations will only be made by UWW/USA Wrestling.

## I. General Information

- 1.1 -The United World Wrestling (U.W.W.) has entrusted the United States of America Wrestling Federation (USAW) with the organization of the 2015 Senior World Championship (GR-FS-FW).
- 1.2 -The 2015 Senior World Championship will be held according to the U.W.W. Rules and Regulations
- 1.3 -The 2015 Senior World Championships in Freestyle, Greco-Roman and Female Wrestling will be prepared by the Organizing Committee set up within the USA Wrestling Federation.
- 1.4 -The 2015 Senior World Championship will take place in the United States of America, Las Vegas 6-12/9/2015.

## III. Participation

- 3.1 -Participation at the 2015 Senior World Championships in Freestyle, Greco-Roman and Female Wrestling is open to all national wrestling federation's affiliated with UWW, provided that they have fulfilled their financial and information obligations toward UWW according to the UWW Statutes and Regulations and towards the Organizing Committee as per these Regulations for the duration of the Championships.  
-Following the General Regulations for International Competitions and Championships (Article 27), the National Wrestling Federation can participate in the Senior Continental Championship with at least the same number of athletes **PER STYLE** than they want to enter in the 2015 Senior World Championships in Las Vegas
- 3.2 -Each national federation has the right to participate with a maximum of one (1) wrestler per weight category in all three styles.

- 3.3 -All competitors must be of senior age (born 1996 or earlier). The age will be verified with the wrestlers' individual passports. The age category of participants is determined according to UWW Regulations. Wrestlers born in 1997 must present a medical certificate justifying the reason for wrestling in a higher age group. Wrestlers are under the entire responsibility of their National Federation.
- 3.4 - All wrestlers must be in possession of a valid license purchased beforehand from UWW.
- 3.5 -The Composition of the official delegation will be in according to the following table as laid down by UWW.

**-Final entries are to be made at 12:00 PM (Noon) on the day of weigh-in.**

-For accreditation purposes a photo must also be attached to the nominative entries. The previous results of the competitors must be sent with the entries, as well as the names, functions and photos of the officials accompanying their teams.

-National Federations will register via the Athena system provided by UWW.

- 4.2 -The above conditions must be respected by the National Federations wishing to attend the Championships in order to book accommodations according to the Regulations.
- 4.3 -Only **IS** referees may officiate in the competition. Referees must present their valid license stamp for the year 2015.

## **V. Technical Conditions**

5.1 -The Competition will be held according to the UWW Rules of Wrestling

5.2 -The Competitions will be conducted in the following weight categories: No weight tolerance is allowed.

-GR: 59, 66, 71, 75, 80, 85, 98, 130kg

-FS: 57, 61, 65, 70, 74, 86, 97, 125kg

-FW: 48, 53, 55, 58, 60, 63, 69, 75kg

5.3 -Four (4) UWW approved mats will be used for the competitions.

5.4 -Each wrestler has to pass a medical examination in his own country at least three days before leaving his country for the competition in the United States. The results of this examination should be recorded in the wrestler's license book.

5.5 -Each wrestler must undergo a medical examination one (1) hour before weigh-in.

- 5.6 -The organizing committee assures the first aid during the competition. The annual license issued by UWW covers the hospital cost for the participating wrestler in case of accident. If an insured person wishes to undergo a medical examination or treatment which is not the consequence of an accident during the Championships, the cost of the such examination or treatment must be borne by the person concerned or by his/her National Federation. The reimbursement of these expenses can under no circumstances be claimed from the insurance company.
- 5.7 -The sampling procedure and the doping control will be conducted according to IOC, WADA and UWW Regulations.

## **VI. Medals and Trophies**

- 6.1 -The organizing committee will give individual prizes for each weight category as follows:
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place: Gold Medal, Certificate
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: Silver Medal, Certificate
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Places: Bronze Medals, Certificates
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Places: Certificates
- 6.2 -Each Participant shall receive a diploma
- 6.3 -The first 3 (three) teams in each style will receive a trophy.
- 6.4 -The points obtained after placing in the individual competition will determine the team classification. The wrestler's places 1<sup>st</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> will receive 10-1 points. If there is a tie for the final classification, the gold, the silver and the bronze medals will be taken into consideration in order to determine the team winner.

- 7.1 -Each participating team must be present at the opening ceremony of the Championships according to the organizing committee's instructions
  - 7.2 -The national flags of the countries whose wrestlers and teams obtained 1<sup>st</sup>—3<sup>rd</sup> places will be hoisted once the medals and cups have been awarded.
  - 7.3 -The national anthem will be played for each individual and team champion.
  - 7.4 -The organizers must provide the flags and national anthems; however, the teams are requested to bring their national flag (100 x 150 cm) and the anthem on a USB Memory Stick which is to be handed over to the organizers at accreditation. Should these items be available for the Organizing Committee in advance it is the team leaders' duty to check them.

## **VIII. Transportation**

- 8.1 -Free Transportation for all delegates paying accreditation fee will be available from McCarran International Airport to The Orleans Hotel & Casino. Competition and lodging will be The Orleans Hotel & Arena. All Transportation information should be sent to USAW by 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2015.

- 9.3 -All delegates have to check-out of the hotel room by 12:00 PM the day of departure.
- 9.4 -Meals corresponding to the calorific value of the UWW Rules (5,000 calories/day) will be served to those accredited in the hotel.
- 9.5 -The Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility neither for people who are not on the list of entries by name nor for those entered over and above the number allowed by the UWW Regulations unless this is agreed beforehand.

## **X. Financial Conditions**

- 10.1 -The delegation's leader shall settle his team's participation and engagement fees to the UWW authorized Organizing Committee and UWW Delegate upon arrival before accreditation for each wrestler per style in one payment. To speed up the accreditation procedure, each nation is recommended to send digital pictures of all participants to the Organizing Committee (along with the final entry) for accreditation cards use.

- 10.2 -No accreditation shall take place without the participation and engagement feeds being paid.
- 10.3 -All participants and accompanying persons are required to pay the authorized Organizing Committee CHF 180, -/day/person including accommodation, meals and local transportation and competition: entry to the hall of competition and possible other activities, arranged by the organizer. The applicable period is the official duration of the Championships plus 2 (two) days before and 1 (one) day after it. The minimum length of accreditation is 4 (four) nights. An engagement fee of CHF 100.-/wrestler or equivalent in EUR or USD is also to be paid to the UWW Delegate.

- 10.4 -In compliance with the provision of article VIII.2 an additional CHF 20,-/person/day is to be paid for the total of CHF 200,- after each single room over the one (1) room quota.

- 10.7 Teams who fail to enter athletes into the online UWW Athena system by the **AUGUST 7<sup>th</sup> DEADLINE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE.** For questions or concerns please contact UWW directly. All **additional delegates** who are seeking accommodations at host hotel or credentials must also apply to UWW and USA Wrestling prior **AUGUST 7<sup>th</sup> DEADLINE** . UWW, USAWRESTLING and ORGANIZER WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE TO GUARANTEE LODGING AND TRANSPORTATION FOR ANY PERSON ADDED AFTER THIS DATE. *NOTE: There is a rather large sporting event that is expected to raise room rates and create hotel rooming shortages in Las Vegas toward the end of the championships.*
- 10.8 -Delegation with more members then allowed in article III.6 of these Regulations as well as delegations (persons) staying more then 9 (nine) days must pay CHF 180,-/day/person.
- 10.9 -UWW Commission members who are called to meet during the Championships will be accredited under the same conditions as the teams present.

10.10 -Delegation leaders will be responsible for any damage incurred by members of their delegation during their stay.

## **XI. Federation Journalists - Video Recordings – Internet**

- 11.1 -The Organizing Committee sends press accreditation and accommodation forms to each national federation. These forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee.
- 11.2 -Federation Journalists are responsible for their own accommodation and board. The Organizing Committee can arrange their accommodation for them on any one of the team's hotels for 180CHF/person/day or equivalent in EUR or US dollars for accommodation, meals and local transportation.
- 11.3 - Federation Journalists can also provide their hotels separately.
- 11.4 -Independent Journalists must apply for accreditation themselves rather than through the Federation. Application process is available. The Organizing committee is not responsible for hotel accommodations. Hotel information is available upon request.
- 11.5 -A Press center comprising all the necessary equipment will be made available to journalists the day before and one day after the Championship.
- 11.6 -Nations wishing to make video camera recording of the Championships must apply for UWW approval one month before the event. The use of such cameras may be permitted by UWW against payment. All approved non-professional cameras shall receive a distinctive camera sticker from the Organizing Committee which is to be clearly and obligatorily put on the camera. Video recordings for educational purposes will be made following a contractual agreement with UWW and with accreditation by the organizers. No numerical video cameras will be accepted in the competition hall without these requirements being followed.
- 11.7 -Television companies which are not members of the ESPN Network must sign a contract with UWW, be accredited and have paid the amount set out in the Financial Regulations in order to receive a unilateral position or obtain images from the recording from the host broadcaster. Non rights holders must agree to restrictions in order to receive accreditation.
