Matches of the Cup will be on two mats at the Sport's Arena (**Apollo** Polyvalent Hall, Address: Bulevardul Energeticienilor nr. 5, sector 3, Bucuresti).

Participants: The First Five teams from the Ranking of the European Championship in Riga, Latvia and Romania (the team of the host federation).

Requirements for participation:

Each delegation should consist of:

- \geq 10 athletes (8+2),
- ➤ 1 Chief of Delegation
- ➤ 2 Coaches
- ➤ 1 Referee
- ➤ 1 Doctor

And

*will provide the Organising committee with their national flag and their national anthem.

Technical Conditions:

The competition will be held in accordance with UWW's wrestling rules.

Referees with international category I and II will officiate the Cup.

The Cup will be held in the following categories:

> FW: 48 kg- 53 kg-55 kg- 58 kg- 60 kg- 63 kg- 69 kg- 75 kg

> FS: 57 kg- 61 kg-65 kg- 70 kg- 74 kg- 86 kg- 97 kg- 125 kg

> GR: 59 kg- 66 kg-71 kg- 75 kg- 80 kg- 85 kg- 98 kg- 130 kg

Tolerance of 2 kg will be allowed for each weight category

Financial Conditions:

The Organisational Committee will provide accommodation, meals and local transport for the participating delegation (13+2).

If needed, first aid will be provided by the Organisational Committee. The cost of hospitalisation will be covered by the participating country.

Travel cost to and from Bucharest is for the expense of the National Federation.

Fee per day for extra people and extra days is 180 CHF.

Prizes:

All participants will receive medals and certificates. The winners in the three styles will receive the European Cup of Nations.
